Purpose of the Workshop

This first regional workshop marks a major milestone in the implementation of the OSF–WB Project "Enhancement of Regional Collaboration in Critical Raw Materials (CRM) and Circular Economy in the Balkans." The event will serve as the first public presentation of preliminary project findings and aims to strengthen cooperation between Albania, Kosovo, and North Macedonia in the fields of secondary CRM resources, industrial waste valorization, and circular economy development.

Three local experts, one from each country will present their initial findings based on technical reports developed under the project, while the International Expert will introduce the integrated model for conducting the pre-feasibility study covering selected sites in Albania, Kosovo, and North Macedonia.

The second part of the workshop is dedicated to youth engagement, bringing together young researchers, innovators, and students from across the region. This session will focus on fostering their active participation in start-ups, recycling initiatives, and innovation-driven projects as a critical component for the sustainable development of CRM secondary resources and circular economy in the Western Balkans.
